
Places to Visit



A short journey from central Tottori City leads you to the awe-inspiring Tottori Sand Dunes, a natural wonder that draws over 1.3 million visitors annually. Begin your adventure here and immerse yourself in the unspoiled beauty of Tottori. Also visit the Sand Museum nearby, which showcases exquisite sand sculptures by world-renowned artists.



Nestled in the heart of Tottori, the 900-meter tall Mt. Mitoku offers stunning scenery year-round. At its center lies the Mitokusan Sanbutsu-ji Temple, renowned for the Nageire-do, a wooden prayer hall dramatically perched in a cave halfway up a cliff. This architectural marvel is a testament to Japan's rich spiritual heritage.



Step back in time as you stroll through Kurayoshi's historic district, featuring the iconic white-walled Shirakabe Warehouses and the red-tiled Akagawara buildings. Photogenic carp swim in the serene waterways, crossed by charming stone bridges. Experience the unique blend of Edo period elegance and modern charm, and enjoy the local gourmet delights and shopping.



The Hakuto-jinja Shrine, dedicated to the mythical white rabbit god, holds a special place in Japanese folklore. According to legend, this is where a white rabbit foretold the union of a local princess and a god. Today, visitors from around the globe come here to seek blessings for love and harmony.
