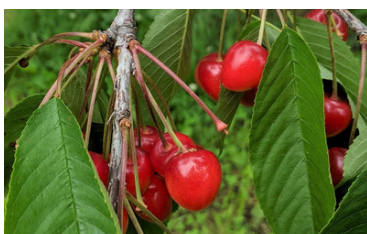

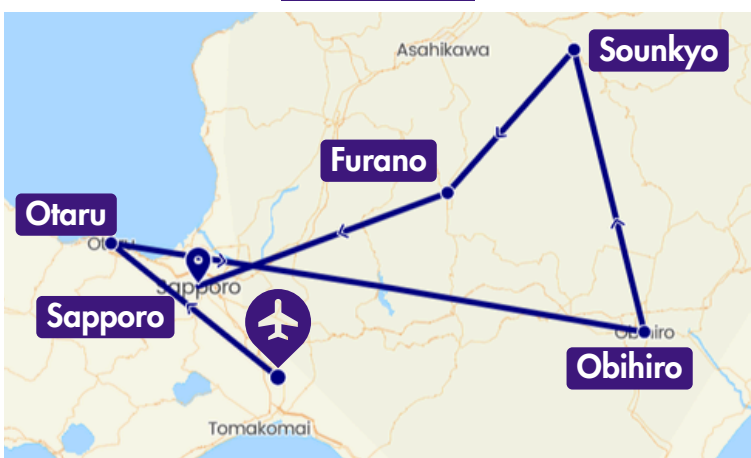

ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 0 Honolulu Departure

Your adventure begins as you depart Honolulu and enjoy the exclusive comfort of the **HIS Lealea Lounge**. Take a smooth, nonstop flight with **Japan Airlines** to Tokyo, where unforgettable experiences await!

Day 1 Arrival in Japan

Portom International Hotel

Arrive at Tokyo-Haneda Airport, then connect to your domestic flight to Hokkaido (CTS). Meet up with your local guide and check in to your comfortable hotel directly connected to the airport. Rest, relax in the *onsen* hot springs, and prepare for the journey ahead!

Day 2 Shakotan and Otaru

Grand Park Hotel Otaru

Head toward the beautiful **Shakotan Peninsula** and stop for a **cherry picking experience** at a local orchard. Next, try light hiking at **Cape Kamui** (not interested in the walk? Don't miss the *shakotan blue* ice cream!), then enjoy a **sake brewery tour plus free tastings** in Otaru.

Day 3 Otaru to Tokachigawa Onsen

Day 4 Tokachi Farms and Fun

Start with a **horsemanship performance plus horse-riding activity** at a local training center. Next, **tour a working farm**, including lunch made with scrumptious local produce. Stroll through **Manabe Garden**, Japan's first conifer garden, then stop at **Naitai Terrace**, the largest public ranch in Japan with highly-recommended ice cream.

Day 5 Sounkyo Onsen to Biei

New Furano Prince Hotel

Ride the **Mt. Kurodake Ropeway** for views over Daisetsuzan National Park, make a photo stop at **Ginga + Ryuuisei Waterfalls**, then transfer to Biei for **Hokusei no Oka View Park** and the iconic **Aoi Ike Blue Pond**.

Day 6 Furano Lavender

New Furano Prince Hotel

Begin the morning with sightseeing at **Farm Tomita**, the biggest lavender farm in Japan. Enjoy a **Furano winery tour plus tastings**, then drop by **Furano Cheese Factory** for excellent *omiyage* shopping and an **ice cream hands-on experience**. Browse local specialty goods at **Furano Marche** and stroll around the picturesque **Ningle Terrace** wooden cabins.

Day 7 Furano to Sapporo

Gateaux Kingdom Sapporo

Start the day with a **Furano Melon farm tour and super-fresh melon tasting**, then transfer to the Sapporo area. Enjoy sightseeing and shopping at **Royce' Cacao & Chocolate Town**, home to the prefecture's most famous chocolatier, then explore the amenities at your resort-style hotel.

Day 8 Sapporo and Surroundings

Sightseeing around the "**Hill of the Buddha**", a site designed by renowned architect Tadao Ando that also features beautiful grounds filled with lavender, then **shopping at Aeon Mall** for staples like Seria (100 yen shop) and Uniqlo.
