ITINERARY OVERVIEW

Day 0 Honolulu Departure

Your adventure begins as you depart Honolulu and enjoy the exclusive comfort of the HIS Lealea Lounge. Take a smooth, nonstop flight with Japan Airlines to Tokyo, where unforgettable experiences await!

Arrival in Japan

Arrive at Tokyo-Haneda Airport, then connect to your domestic flight to Hokkaido (CTS). Meet up with your local guide and check in to your comfortable hotel directly connected to the airport. Rest, relax in the onsen hot springs, and prepare for the journey ahead!

Furano and Obihiro

Head to Furano area in central Hokkaido, enjoy sightseeing at Farm Tomita (Japan's most famous lavender farm!), then move to Sahoro "Bear Mountain" for an up-close look at these powerful but oh-so-cute furballs.

Day 3 Journey to Lake Akan

Stop by Akan International Crane Center to observe rare Red-crowned Cranes, then try a Kushiro River canoeing activity (no experience needed!) while watching for wildlife on shore. Check out a "Lost Kamuy" traditional Ainu music and dance performance this evening.

Shiretoko Splendor Day 6

Walk the restricted **Shiretoko Five Lakes trail** (3 km) with a specialist nature guide, **ride a cruise ship** around the peninsula's coast and look for wildlife on shore, then enjoy a super-unique "**Night Safari**" guided tour to discover nocturnal animals when they are most active in their natural habitat.

Shiretoko to Abashiri

Check out the towering Oshin Koshin waterfalls, then move toward Abashiri and wander the colorful fields of Koshimizu Wild Flower Park. Pick your own succulent cherries at a local orchard before heading to the Abashiri Prison Museum to admire the impressive wax figurines at this historical site.

Return to Central Hokkaido

Head west toward Asahikawa and sightsee around Ueno Flower Garden (an idyllic English-style garden), tasting & shopping at the **Otokoyama Sake Museum**, then browse local sweets and *omiyage* at **Tsuboya Kibana no** Mori, one of Hokkaido's oldest confectionaries.
