Feb 25 Honolulu Departure

Feb 25 Arrival in Japan

Feb 27 Tokyo Secrets

Mitsui Garden Nihonbashi Premier

Uncover lesser-known destinations within Japan's capital. Gotokuji Temple is known as the birthplace of *maneki neko* "lucky cat" figurines, then wander Koishikawa Garden during the Plum Blossom festival. Enjoy shopping around the lively Toyosu Senkyaku Banrai market.

Feb 28 Saitama Countryside

Take a day trip like a local! Head to neighboring Saitama and board a traditional riverboat in Nagatoro for a scenic cruise, then ride a ropeway for panoramic views of the countryside. Stop by historic Chichibu Shrine, known for its bright, colorful carvings created by the same artisans behind Nikko's World Heritage Toshogu Mausoleum.

Mar 1 Kawagoe Charm

Known as "Little Edo" for its wonderfully preserved townscape, head to Kawagoe while visiting Omiya Bonsai Museum (the world's first public facility dedicated to bonsai art!) as well as Kimbue Shoyu Factory on the way. You'll then explore the nostalgic streets of Kawagoe to soak up its traditional architecture and fascinating local stores. Don't miss "Candy Alley," home to a variety of old-fashioned sweets shops!

Mar 2 Yokohama Fun

Head down to Tokyo's next-door neighbor of Yokohama! Take in tranquil Sankeien Garden, featuring seasonal flowers, then move to the country's most famous Chinatown district and stroll the vibrant streets at your own pace. Mar 3 Scenic Chiba

Head to Chiba's Boso Peninsula and sightsee around Mother Farm, a ranch with fields of brilliant golden rapeseed flowers, then pick scrumptious strawberries at a local orchard. Move to Spa Resort Mikazuki and dip into the sprawling hot springs baths or just wander the extensive grounds. Make a quick stop by Toriizaki Park for impressive views of Tokyo across the bay.
