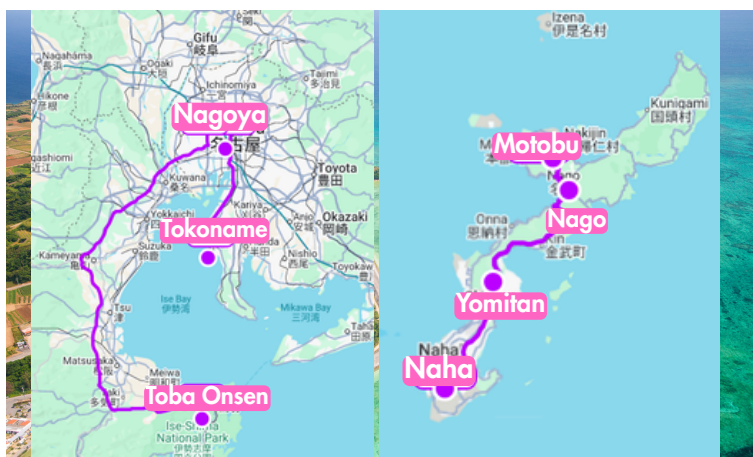

Day 0 Honolulu Departure

Begin your journey by meeting your tour leader and fellow travelers at Honolulu Airport. Relax before your flight to Nagoya with Japan Airlines (JAL), known for their outstanding in-flight service and excellent meals.

Day 1 Arrival in Japan

Hotel Nagashima

Welcome to Japan! After landing, pass through immigration and customs before meeting your local Japanese guide. Head to your comfortable hotel, rest, relax, and slip into your first *onsen*. 17 types of baths await!

Day 2 Nagoya and Surroundings

Hotel Nagashima

Have a leisurely morning at your hotel, then head out to Nagoya City. Take in the splendor of Nagoya Castle, one of the country's most impressive keeps, plus shopping at *Kinshachi Yokochi*. Head back to your hot springs hotel and spend the evening enjoying the many baths!

Day 3 Snow and Strawberries

Toba Ocean Resort

Take a ropeway ride up Mt. Gozaisho and pass into a snowy world far removed from ordinary life. If you're fortunate, you'll get to see *juhyou* "ice monsters" on the trees, formed by moisture freezing onto the branches. After returning from your alpine excursion, savor sweet strawberries at a local fruit farm, then move to your hotel in Toba Onsen.

Day 4 Pretty Pearls

Toba Ocean Resort

Travel to Mikimoto "Pearl Island", where pearl cultivation began in the late 19th century. Have a special seafood lunch from traditional *ama* female divers, then try a pearl harvesting experience to find your own shiny jewel. Return to your hotel and slide into soothing hot springs.

Day 5 Ise and Shimakaze Train

Nagoya Tokyu Hotel

Get in some shopping at Okage Yokochi, then explore Ise Grand Shrine, the country's most sacred and important Shinto location. Ride the luxury sightseeing "Shimakaze" train back to Nagoya. Have a premium teppanyaki steak dinner and get ready for Okinawa!

Day 6 On to Okinawa

Hotel Collective

Spend the morning in Tokoname, a town known for its pottery traditions and sake breweries, then depart for Okinawa, arriving in Naha in the early evening. Enjoy your first meal on the island complete with a *ryukyu* dance performance. Check into your comfortable hotel and relax.

Day 7 Ryukyu Village and Sakura

Oriental Hotel Okinawa

Discover Ryukyu Village, an open-air cultural park dedicated to preserving the distinct history, architecture, and lifestyle of the Ryukyu Kingdom. Take in the pink wonder of some of Japan's earliest cherry blossoms at Nangusuku Park, then move to your resort hotel.

Day 8 Whale Sharks and Sakura

Oriental Hotel Okinawa

Marvel at the behemoth whale sharks at famous Churaumi Aquarium, home to one of the largest tanks in the world. Explore UNESCO World Heritage site Nakijin Castle Ruins for the gorgeous rows of dark pink cherry blossom trees blooming along the castle's pathways.

Day 9 Ryukyu Lantern Festival

Hotel Nikko Alivila

Absorb the stunning scenery of Cape Manzamo, famous for a unique rock formation that resembles an elephant's trunk. Explore Yachimun Pottery Village renowned for authentic Okinawan earthenware. Spend the evening at the colorful Ryukyu Lantern Festival, filled with glowing paper lanterns.

Day 10 Naha and Surroundings

Hotel Collective

Wander UNESCO World Heritage site Shuri Castle, then find your perfect gifts at Parco City shopping mall, including favorite brands like Daiso, Muji, and Uniqlo. Check in to your Naha hotel and enjoy some free time before savoring a deluxe farewell dinner to celebrate your journey.
